The course aims at people with:  
Swiss federal vocational education and training diploma, academic baccalaureate (Swiss matura - university-entrance diploma), Swiss federal certificate or diploma of higher vocational education and training, bachelor or a degree in an equivalent education.

The following examination accreditation requirements have to be fulfilled:

## Project management experience

- **Candidates with at least a bachelor degree or an equivalent diploma**  
(Swiss federal vocational education and training diploma, Swiss federal diploma of higher vocational education and training):
  - 4'500 hour experience in project management
  - 36 month experience (without overlap) in project management over the past 8 years
  - 35 hour further education in project management
- **Candidates with at least an academic baccalaureate (university-entrance diploma) or an equivalent degree**  
(Swiss federal certificate of competence, professional baccalaureate):
  - 7'500 hour experience in project management
  - 36 month experience (without overlap) in project management over the past 8 years
  - 35 hour further education in project management

## Training methods

## Certificate

The PMP® certificate identifies you as internationally recognized specialist and experienced project manager.

## Information about PMI®

The Project Management Institute PMI® is a global organisation, that developed and maintains the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK®). PMI® is represented with its 200'000 members in more than 125 countries.

The PMBOK® is de facto the standard work for project management.

## Examination

The examination lasts 4 hours and contains 200 multiple choice questions each with 4 answer choices. Basis of the questions is the PMBOK®.

## Validity period of examination

The certificate is valid 3 years and is renewable.

## Educational goals

The education is a preparation for the PMP® examination and shall close knowledge gaps from the participants. In addition possible ambiguity and uncertainty related to a successful certification are eliminated. The requirements for examination accreditation is fulfilled with the attendance at the courses.
